## Ohio Weather Notes

**Zanesville 6N #48 (Muskingum County) Thomas Ruggles** - April was a beautiful month this year with blooming trees spectacular and no killing freeze. The major weather event here occurred in the evening of the 28th and the early morning of the 29th. Temperatures fell during the day on the 28th, and a thunderstorm about 11 p.m. produced accumulating hail, enough to close Interstate 70 for a time. We then awoke to snow on decks and grassy surfaces on the 29th. Some areas close by here had up to 2 inches on the ground.
