Ohio Weather Notes

Wilmington 10NW #125 (Clinton County) Aaron Hohenbrink - October was a little cooler and wetter than normal. On the 30th, we had almost an inch of snow fall, but it quickly melted away in the morning.

Zanesville 6N #48 (Muskingum County) Thomas Ruggles - A surprise to many was a beautiful fall foliage display in October. An "Indian Summer" week was balanced against a cold, windy week thanks to Super Storm Sandy. Precipitation for the month was significantly above normal primarily due to Sandy. One AM temperature dropped below freezing, but there was no killing freeze.
